**PROCLAMATION IMPOSING A CURFEW
PURSUANT TO THE STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARED
BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE**

SECTION I – By prior proclamation dated the 10th day of September 2018, I determined that a state of emergency as defined in General Statute §14-288 *et.seq.* and a state of threatened disaster as defined in General Statute §166A-1 *et.seq.* existed in the City of Jacksonville, North Carolina due to the approach and proximity of Hurricane Florence.

SECTION II – By that State of Emergency Proclamation, I declared the existence of a State of Emergency and Threatened Disaster in the City of Jacksonville, North Carolina.

SECTION III – By that State of Emergency Proclamation, I reserved the right to declare a curfew for the City of Jacksonville.

SECTION IV – Pursuant to Ordinance 89-33 of the Jacksonville City Code for Emergency Preparedness, and upon consultation with appropriate county, municipal, and law enforcement officers and personnel, I hereby declare a curfew in effect from **7:00 p.m. THURSDAY the 13th day of SEPTEMBER until 7:00 a.m. SUNDAY, the 16TH day of SEPTEMBER, 2018.** This time frame may be extended pursuant to the authority delegated to the City Manager in Section IV of the State of Emergency Proclamation.

SECTION V – In order to preserve the public health, safety, and welfare of Jacksonville citizens, and to protect their property as a result of evacuations and the threat of possible looting, I hereby restrict the appearance in public during the aforementioned period of anyone except law enforcement, emergency services personnel, emergency utility workers, and elected and appointed county and municipal officials. I further order that, with the exception of business or establishments that provide emergency services, all offices, business establishments, and other places to or from which people may travel or at which they may congregate are strongly encouraged be closed during the aforementioned period.

SECTION VI – I hereby order this proclamation to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public, unless the circumstances of the State of Emergency or Disaster prevent or impede, to be promptly filed with the City Clerk of the City of Jacksonville and hereby posted in the City Hall.

SECTION VII – This curfew shall be effective until rescinded in writing.

SECTION VIII – Onslow County Alcohol Beverage Control (ABC) stores will close **7:00 p.m. THURSDAY the 13th day of SEPTEMBER until 7:00 a.m. SUNDAY, the 16TH day of SEPTEMBER, 2018.**


SECTION IX – This proclamation shall become effective immediately and shall continue until it is rescinded in writing.
