JREL Rocket League Tournament Rules

Registration Deadline – June 25, 2020

Date of Event – June 25, 2020

In Game Settings

- Match time: 5 minutes
- 5 point score limit will be used (first to 5 goals wins)
- No Bots
- Server Region is US East
- All maps that are currently available are in play and will be randomized

* Players may play on any platform with a keyboard/mouse or a controller.

**All games will continue even if there are technical difficulties related to but not limited to internet issues, controller or keyboard/mouse issues, computer issues, etc.

***Players who leave the game can join the game mid-game if they are able, but there will be no substituting or bots allowed during the tournament.

Tournament Format

The Tournament Administrator will create multiple tournaments using the Tournament option in Rocket League.

These Tournaments will be private and username/password protected.

- 16 Players Max
- 2v2 Soccer
- **Preliminary Matches** - Multiple tournaments will be created and player placement will be done randomly in brackets.
- The number of preliminary match tournaments that will be created within Rocket League will be determined by the number of players that register for the tournament.
- All preliminary matches will be best of one.
- **Playoffs** - Rocket League Tournament format is single elimination so after prelim play the top teams in each pool will play in a final single elimination tournament to determine the winner.
- All playoff matches are best of three.

Conduct

- All decisions and disagreements will be decided by the Tournament Administrator who will be present at the time of the tournament.
- Any malfunctions are the player's responsibility. No matches will be restarted.
- No substitutions are allowed
- DQ Rule: If both your players are not there for the match, you automatically give up the match.
- The Tournament Administrator has the right to save/record any tournament match if possible and has the right to upload said match.
- Intentional forfeiting, match fixing, splitting and any other forms of bracket manipulation is not allowed and is punishable by the Tournament Administrator.
- Disrupting an opponent physically or intending to disrupt their play (Discord) will result in a warning. Repeated action may result in disqualification from the tournament.
- Observers who disrupt players are dealt with at the Tournament Administrator sees fit. Disqualification is the most common recourse.
- Do not argue with Tournament Moderators, Administrators or Staff.
- Any inappropriate language/pictures/videos/text (Discord) are subject to immediate disqualification and banning from the server.
- The Tournament Administrator is the ultimate rule decider and can form new rules and enforce them as they see fit. The Tournament Administrator is the ultimate decider of all disputes and problems. Arguing with the Tournament Administrator may result in immediate ejection from the tournament.
